

Ethics Training Program for Local Government Elected Officials, Managers & Supervisors

Thursday, January 19, 2017 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm

Government Code Section 53235 requires local government officials (members of a legislative body) who receive any type of compensation or reimbursement for expenses to receive at least two hours of ethics training every two years.

To fulfill the requirements of this legislation, the Yucaipa Valley Water District will be sponsoring a free Ethics Training Program on <u>Thursday, January 19, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.</u> The two hour program will be held at the Yucaipa Valley Regional Water Filtration Facility located at 35477 Oak Glen Road, Yucaipa.

A light meal will be provided starting at 5:30 p.m. with the training scheduled session to begin promptly at 6:00 p.m. The cost for this training is free, but space is limited and pre-registration is encouraged to receive your certificate of completion. Individuals that arrive after 6:00 p.m. are encouraged to attend a separate session to meet the full two-hour training requirement.
